Newington Green.


 1683-Started his business career, traveling to sell wind and wool.


◆ 1692- Finally went bankrupt.



Literary Works


- Daniel Defoe was interested in politics and wrote his first literary piece in a political pamphlet.

- Roxana was the last literary piece that was written besides editorial pieces in which he continues a year after.


