- ◆ Born and death occurred in London.



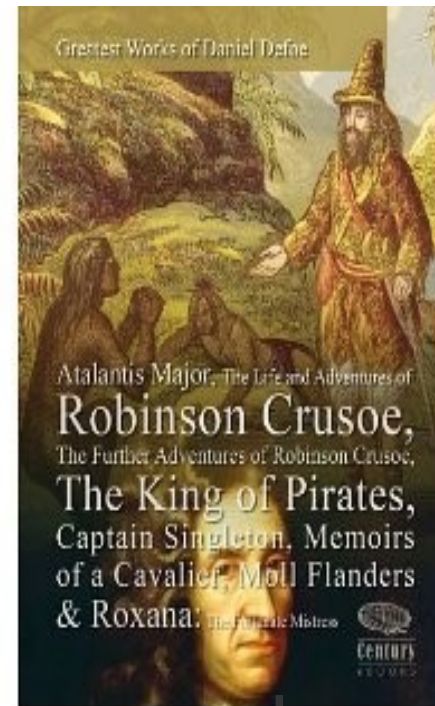
Education

- ◆ 1692- Finally went bankrupt.



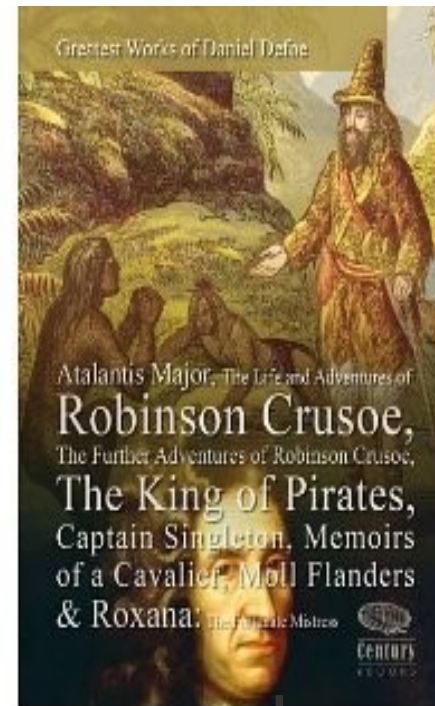
Literary Works
