- Socializing: starting a conversation, introducing oneself and others, inviting – accepting/ declining
- Enquiring: asking for and giving information
- Helping: asking for and offering help
 expressing gratitude
- Permission and request: asking for and giving permission, making a request and responding
- Expressing moral attitudes: apologizing, granting forgiveness, expressing approval/ disapproval, expressing wishes and regrets Expressing intellectual attitudes: expressing agreement / disagreement
- Suasion (getting things done): suggesting a course of action, requesting others to do something
