

1) Difference between Tricot and rachel warp knitting machine?

Ans: Below is the difference of Tricot and rachel warp knitting machine:

Tricot warp knitting m/c.	rachel warp knitting m/c.
i) Tricot m/c mainly employed bearded needles with a pressure bar.	i) rachel m/c used latch needles.
ii) Chain link numbering is 1, 2, 3, 4, ... etc	ii) Chain link numbered in even numbers 0, 2, 4, ... etc.
iii) Mechanical attention is carried out at the front of the m/c	iii) Mechanical attention is carried out at the back of the m/c.

↳ Fine gauge only

↳ uses: sport wears,
sheep wear.

w) Low Speed Production.

↳ Fine to coarse gauge.

↳ uses: nets dress fabric,
blankets.
